

Volunteer Areas of Service
(Not all areas of service are required at each event.
You will be informed when we hear from you)

Load-In:

- a. Loaders – unload equipment from hauler, carry/roll heavy equipment to stage
- b. Stagehands – setup stage

Show-Call:

- a. Stage hands – reset stage for next act
- b. Spotlights – run spotlights during show

Load-Out:

- a. Loaders – carry/roll out heavy equipment and load hauler
- b. Stagehands – teardown stage

Technicians:

- a. Electrician (must be licensed)
- b. Monitor Engineer
- c. FOH Mix Engineer
- d. Stage Manager

House Production Team:

- a. Chief Sound Engineer
- b. Lighting Operator
- c. Video Projection Operator
- d. PowerPoint Operator
- e. Camera Operators

Logistical Support:

Courier/Driver – (reserved for concert host)

Artist Attendant – assists with artist needs while at the venue

Security (doors) – stands or sits at a venue door directing attendees to front entrance

Food Attendant – helps setup food when it arrives for artists and volunteers. Clean-up.

Merch Sales – sells artist merchandise and assists with packing-up artist merch at end

Ticket Seller at the door – sells tickets at the door

Ticket Will Call – distributes tickets to people who have tickets waiting for them at door

Ticket Checker / Greeters – checks peoples tickets as they enter

Usher (seating) – helps people find their seat

Photography – takes professional photos of event before, during and after event with own digital camera. Downloads and burns pics in JPG format onto CD (2 copies) to give to Concert Host within one week after the event.
